Palm Beach Coin Club & Show Rules

- 1. NO one should knowingly sell counterfeit or fake coins or gold or silver jewelry at the show or club.
- 2. If an item is deemed to be counterfeit, the seller MUST take it back. Always get a receipt for expensive items. Buyers can ask for a receipt.
- 3. ALL gold & silver jewelry should have paperwork. By law, when buying jewelry, it has to be written up and sellers information taken. Any guarantees should be in writing, whether for coins or jewelry.
- 4. Disagreements should be handled peacefully and quietly. Do not disrupt the show.
- 5. Keep all receipts and paperwork. No receipt, no case. Without paperwork, it's he said, she said.
- 6. If a perfectly good item is sold, both the buyer and seller agree on a price & grade, then the buyer wants the money back, it is at the discretion of the seller whether to refund the money.
- 7. IF A DEALER BREAKS THESE RULES, IT IS AT THE DESCRESSION OF THE PBCC BOARD WHAT ACTION TO TAKE, FROM EXPULTION OF THE DEALER AND OR CUSTOMER TO NO ACTION, AS PER RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE CITY, COUNTY, STATE, AND FEDERAL LAWS.
